The goal of a Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) is to **provide you with improved health** by working with you as a team to meet your healthcare needs and always striving for improvement.

WHAT IS A MEDICAL HOME?

A Medical Home provides **personalized healthcare** by offering a team of
healthcare practitioners, financial
service specialists, and coordinators
who **provide evidence-based care to manage your health needs.** The aim is
to improve overall health and wellbeing.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT

At Your Medical Home, you can choose or be assigned to a doctor or nurse practitioner and his/her Care Team. Simply inform our staff during check-in or anytime during your care. The Care Team manages your visits, specialist referrals, tests, and responses to inquiries. We prioritize your family's care, offering same-day appointments and after-hours support for urgent needs. Established patients may access the Patient Portal for 24/7 viewing of medical information and appointment requests.

BE A PART OF THE TEAM!

To be successful as your patient centered medical home we need you to play an active part in the healthcare team.

Here are some things you can do to help:

- Inform of us immediately of any visits to other healthcare providers, specialists, emergency/urgent care visits, hospitalizations, etc.
- Bring any old records, paperwork, discharge summaries, etc. that you may have from these visits. If you do not have a copy of old records, please sign a release of medical information so that we can receive these records.
- Always inform the Emergency Department, Urgent Care, specialists, etc., that we are your primary care provider.
- Always bring an updated list of medications, including doses, with you to your appointment.
- Keep your contact information up-to-date.
- Don't be afraid to share information with your provider/care team! ASK for help!
- ASK questions if you don't understand! All questions are welcome!
